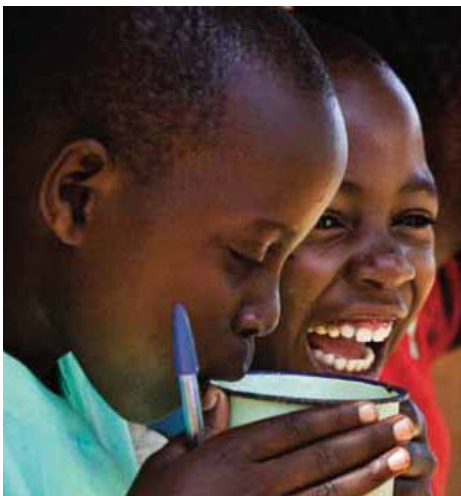
*Minutes continued....* for which some of these individuals are unable to mentally adjust.
